

**MOTION TO CLOSE THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF CIVIL DISTRICT COURT**

**ON MOTION OF** Chelsey Richard Napoleon, Clerk of Civil District Court for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, appearing herein and on suggesting to the Court, due to possible dangers associated with the weather advisory and inclement weather currently in place for the Parish of Orleans associated with Tropical Storm Ida; as a result, the possible dangers of extreme weather conditions will create hazardous and unsafe conditions for employees working at 421 Loyola Avenue, New Orleans, and 1340 Poydras Street, New Orleans, and for the general public conducting business with the Clerk’s Office on Friday August 27, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. and Monday, August 30, 2021, and on further suggesting to the court that her office should be closed under provisions of La. R.S. 1:55 so that such closure will be considered a legal holiday so that prescription will be interrupted as to all lawsuits to be filed with her office on the aforesaid date, and on further suggesting to the Court that written approval was given by the Chief Judge of Civil District Court and was followed by written approval of the Chief Judge of the Civil District Court was given as required by the statute to authorize such a closure.

**IT IS ORDERED** that the Clerk of Civil District Court is authorized to close the Clerk of Civil District Court, Civil Division and Land Records Division (Mortgage and Conveyance) on, Friday, August 27, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. and Monday, August 30, 2021, and said closure shall have the same force and effect as a legal holiday pursuant to La. R.S. 1:55; and the Clerk, shall follow the advertising and statement requirements of said section. All offices will re-open Tuesday, August 31, 2021.
