**Colonial Act Types Seminar: Thursday, October 17, 9 AM - 12 PM**

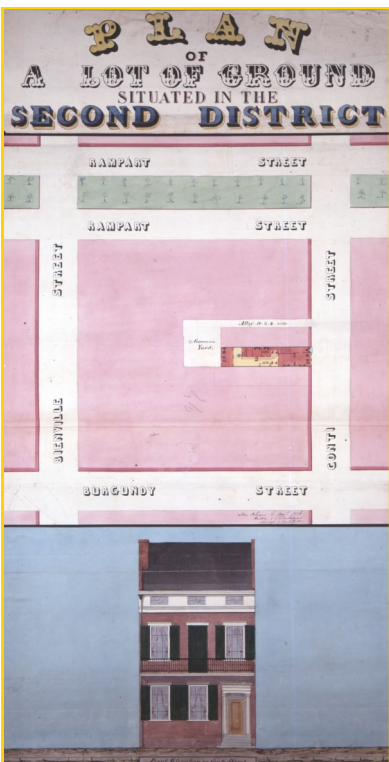
Explore the origins and meanings of French and Spanish Colonial notarial acts in our new morning seminar. Please register to attend by **October 10**.
