RE: **Filing Fee Increase Effective August 1, 2016**
Pursuant to La. R.S. 13: 86 (Act 131 of the 2016 Regular Legislative Session)

Pursuant to La. R.S. (Act 131 of the 2016 Regular Legislative Session), effective August 1, 2016, the clerk of the Supreme Court and each city, parish, juvenile, family, district and appellate court shall impose and collect from each party liable for court costs the additional sum of fifty cents for the initial filing in **all civil matters.**

All funds collected pursuant to this statute shall be deposited into a special account and transmitted monthly to the Supreme Court and shall be used to defray the costs associated with the general growth and program improvement strategies of the Judicial College.

CIVIL FILING FEE SCHEDULE

Pursuant to Local Rule 5, the following fee schedule reflects the most current increases to the filing fees. Filing fees shall be paid to the Clerk of Court at the time pleadings are filed. Pursuant to La. R.S. 13:86 (Act 131 of the 2016 Regular Session), effective August 1, 2016, the Clerks of District Courts shall impose and collect from each party liable for court costs the additional sum of fifty cents for the initial filing in all civil matters. The filing fee authorized by LA. R.S. 13:10.3, relative to the Judges' Supplemental Compensation Fund, was increased by \$0.50 from \$23.50 to \$24.00, effective July 1, 2015. **THE FOLLOWING COSTS SHALL BE PAID TO THE CLERK OF COURT AT THE TIME OF FILING OF THE PLEADING SPECIFIED. IN ALL INSTANCES, THE AMOUNT PROVIDED FOR IS NOT A DEPOSIT, BUT IS A NON-REFUNDABLE FILING FEE.**

1. If the amendment or supplementation is to correct a typographical error or to specifically name a party generically referred to (e.g. XYZ Corp., or Jane Doe) in the original pleading, no fee will be assessed. Effective 7/1/00
 2. Specifically, Motions for Summary Judgment, prescription, res judicata, no cause of action, no right of action, lack of jurisdiction over the person of the defendant, and lack of jurisdiction over the subject of the action. Effective 7/1/00
 3. This fee is assessed to each motion to compel discovery. Separate discovery matters shall be assessed separately even if filed jointly in one motion. Effective 7/1/00
