MOTION TO CLOSE THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF CIVIL DISTRICT COURT

ON MOTION OF Chelsey Richard Napoleon, Clerk of Civil District Court for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, appearing herein and on suggesting to the Court, possible inclement weather impacting the office which causes a public health safety concern; as a result, the possible dangers will create hazardous and unsafe conditions for employees working in the building at 421 Loyola Avenue, New Orleans, and 1340 Poydras Street, New Orleans, and the general public conducting business with the Clerk's Office on Tuesday January 16, 2024 and on further suggesting to the court that her office should be closed under provisions of La. R.S. 1:55 so that such closure will be considered a legal holiday so that prescription will be interrupted as to all lawsuits to be filed with her office on the aforesaid date, and on further suggesting to the Court that written approval was given by the Chief Judge of Civil District Court and was followed by written approval of the Chief Judge of the Civil District Court was given as required by the statute to authorize such a closure. The office shall re-open on Wednesday, January 17, 2024.


IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of Civil District Court is authorized to close the Clerk of Civil District Court's Office: Civil Division and Land Records Division (Mortgage and Conveyance) on, Tuesday, January 16, 2024. All offices will re-open Wednesday, January 17, 2024.

Said closure shall have the same force and effect as a legal holiday pursuant to La. R.S. 1:55; and the Clerk, shall follow the advertising and statement requirements of said section.
